

Dalian University of Foreign Languages Application Information for Confucius Institute Scholarship 2018



Dalian University of Foreign Languages (DUFL), located in the beautiful coastal city of Dalian, is under the jurisdiction of Liaoning Provincial Government. DUFL currently has 21 faculties and departments, offering 33 undergraduate programs, 22 graduate programs and 1 doctoral program. We have a total of 20,000 students, including master's degree candidates, undergraduates, and international students as well as short-term trainees. DUFL is established in 1964 in the name of Dalian School of Japanese Language with the attention from the late Chinese Premier Zhou Enlai. The university is a national multilingual base for promoting the Chinese language and awarded as the Chinese president office of Shanghai Cooperation Organization. It is the Chinese and Russian students exchange base and "Million Project" for Hong Kong universities under the Ministry of Education, the first Education Training Base for international students in Liaoning province. It is also designated to take in international students sponsored by Chinese Government Scholarship, Confucius Institute Scholarship, Liaoning Provincial Government Scholarship and Dalian Municipal Government Scholarship. Over the years, DUFL has been entrusted to undertake 9 overseas Confucius institutes in Russia, Japan, Korea, Colombia, Guyana, Brazil, Armenia, Portugal and Italy respectively.

School of Chinese Studies (SCS) at Dalian University of Foreign Languages was founded in 1985. Since its establishment, SCS has played an important role in teaching international students Chinese as a foreign language in China. It serves as a National HSK Testing Centre in Dalian, one of the first Education Training Bases for International Students in Liaoning province, and a National Multilingual Base for Promoting Chinese Language. Every year nearly 2,000 international students from more than 50 countries study at SCS for long-term or short-term courses, or for Bachelor's degree, Master's degree or Doctor's degree. When achieving a certain level of Chinese, the international students can also study with Chinese students in other departments on campus.

For the purpose of cultivating qualified Chinese language teachers and facilitating the promotion of Chinese language and culture, the Confucius Institute Headquarters (Hanban) launches "Confucius Institute Scholarship" (CIS) to support outstanding students, scholars and currently employed Chinese language teachers recommended by Confucius Institutes, independently operated Confucius Classrooms as well as some HSK test centers (hereinafter to be collectively referred to as "recommending institutions") to study in Chinese universities and colleges (hereinafter referred to as "host institutions"). Introduction of Confucius Institute Scholarship Dalian University of Foreign Languages 2018 is as follows:

Eligibility, Coverage and Entry Requirements

Recruitment category of 2018 includes: Scholarship for Master's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (MTC SOL), for Bachelor's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (BTC SOL), for One-Academic-Year Study, for One-Semester Study and for Four-Week Study.

Application is open to non-Chinese citizens, who are in good Physical and mental condition, well performed both academically and behaviorally, Aspired to take future careers on the teaching or international promotion of Chinese language, between the ages of 16-35 on September 1st, 2018. Applicants currently worked as Chinese language teachers shall not exceed the age limit of 45, while undergraduate students shall not exceed the age limit of 25.

Confucius Institute Scholarship covers tuition fee, accommodation fee, living allowance (excluding four-week study students), and comprehensive medical insurance. Further details can be found in Confucius Institute Scholarship Coverage and Standards.

MTC SOL: This category, commences September 2018, provides a sponsorship for two academic years. A minimum score of 210 in HSK (Level 5) and at least 60 in HSKK (Intermediate Level) is required. Applicant who is able to provide the employment agreement or certification upon finishing the study from designated working institutions is preferred.

The main courses include: Chinese linguistics, Second language acquisition, Chinese culture and communication, Cross-cultural communication, Teaching Chinese as a second language, Analysis and practice of Chinese classroom teaching etc.

BTC SOL: This category, commences September 2018, provides a sponsorship for 4 years. A minimum score of 210 in HSK (Level 4) and at least 60 in HSKK (Intermediate Level) is required.

The main courses include: Basic Chinese, Oral Chinese, Chinese writing, Overview of China, Chinese grammar and grammar teaching, Special theme of HSK, Chinese skill teaching etc...

Scholarship for One-Academic-Year Study: This category, commences September 2018, provides a sponsorship for 11 months. International students who studying in China now are not eligible for the scholarship.

MTC SOL: at least **270 in HSK (Level 3)**, and have **HSKK** scores.

The main courses include: Basic Chinese, Chinese listening, Oral Chinese etc.. Students can select courses like Chinese grammar, Chinese culture, Taiji, Wushu, Chinese painting, Calligraphy etc.. Equivalent to elementary (high level) class.

Chinese literature: at least **180 in HSK (Level 4)**, and **HSKK 60 (intermediate level)** scores.

The main courses include: Intensive Chinese, Chinese listening and speaking, Chinese reading etc.. Students can select courses like Overview of Chinese history, Chinese culture, Lecture of traditional Chinese medicine science, Chinese grammar etc.. Equivalent to intermediate(low level) class.

Chinese course: at least **180 in HSK (Level 3)**

The main courses include: Basic Chinese, Chinese listening and speaking, Oral Chinese etc.. Students can select courses like Chinese culture, Taiji, Wushu, Chinese painting, Calligraphy etc.. Equivalent to elementary (intermediate level) class.

Scholarship for One-Semester Study: This category, commences September 2018 or March 2019, provides a sponsorship for five months. Applicants who already have X1 or X2 visa will be refused.

BTC SOL and Chinese Literature: a minimum score of **210 in HSK (Level 3)** and have **HSKK** scores.

The main courses include: Basic Chinese, Chinese listening, Oral Chinese etc.. Students can select courses like Chinese grammar, Chinese culture, Taiji, Wushu, Chinese painting, Calligraphy etc.. Equivalent to elementary (intermediate level) class.

Scholarship for Four-Week Study: Register from July 28th to July 29th 2018 and lasts for four weeks. Applicant must apply in group through their Confucius Institute. One group can only be 10-15 members. Applicants should have HSK scores and who already have X1 or X2 visa will be refused.

The main courses include: Basic Chinese, Chinese listening etc.. Students can select Chinese cultural courses like Taiji, Wushu, Chinese knots, Chinese painting, paper cutting etc.. Equivalent to elementary (low level) class.

Admission Procedure: Online registration will be available from March 1, 2018 on the Confucius Institute Scholarship website (cis.chinese.cn). Please log on to search recommending institutions and host institutions, upload application materials online, track the application progress, feedback of review and admission results. Scholarship holders need to confirm with DUFL to go through the procedures of studying in China, print out CIS certificate online, and register at DUFL at the designated date and time as per the letter of admission.

Confucius Institute headquarters will make the final decision 2 month before class begins. Deadline of scholarship is **April 10th 2018 for Four-Week Study, and June 10th for other categorizes.**

CIS Coverage and Standards

CIS is categorized into full scholarship and partial scholarship based on its coverage. Full scholarship recipients are exempt from tuition and accommodation fees, and are provided with living allowance (excluding four-week study students), and comprehensive medical insurance. Partial scholarship recipients are exempt from tuition and accommodation fees and are provided with comprehensive medical insurance.

Tuition fee is under the overall planning and utilization of host institutions to provide teaching, management, and cultural activities for scholarship holders. The tuition fee covers fees for two Chinese language proficiency tests (HSK and HSKK) that both students for advance study and for degree are required to take before ending of the course or before annual assessment and graduation, and **excludes fees for textbooks and admission tickets of tourist attractions.**

Accommodation fee is under the overall planning and utilization of host institutions. Free apartments (usually double rooms) on campus are available for scholarship students. Students can either apply for international student apartments on campus or live off campus. For those who live off campus with the permission of DUFL are entitled to accommodation allowance by month or by quarter. The allowance criterion is RMB 700 per person monthly.

Living allowance is granted to full scholarship holders by host institutions monthly. The allowance criterion per person is: undergraduates, one-academic-year students and one-semester students are granted with 2,500 RMB per person per month; MTCSOL students are granted with 3,000 RMB per person per month.

Scholarship holders are required to complete enrollment procedures within stipulated time-period in each semester, otherwise, their scholarship will be cancelled.

Students who are enrolled before the 15th (or on the 15th) of the admission month, are entitled to the full allowance of that month. Students, who are enrolled after the 15th of that month, are only entitled to half of the allowance. The living allowance for the month of graduation will be granted half a month later upon confirming the graduation status by host institutions.

During the study, for any student who is absent from China due to personal reasons for more than 15 days (excluding winter and summer holidays), the allowance will be suspended during absence.

For students who suspend study, drop out of school or disciplined by the university for personal reasons, allowance will be terminated on the date of schooling suspension, dropping out or when the decision punishment is announced.

Comprehensive medical insurance is purchased by the host institutions in accordance to relevant regulations on international students stipulated by the Ministry of Education of China. Insurance fee per person is 160 RMB for four-week study students, 400 RMB for one-semester students, and 800 RMB per year for students engaged in program longer than one academic year.

Application Documents for CIS

Recommending institutions and host institutions should examine the completeness, validity and accuracy of applicant's name, nationality and permanent address on the passport. If the following documents are not in Chinese or English version, notarization documents should be provided.

For all applicants:

A scanned copy of the passport photo page. Applicants under the age of 18 shall submit relevant documents of entrusted legal guardians in China, who can be Chinese citizens or non-Chinese residing in China.

Scanned copies of score reports of HSK and HSKK (valid for two years).

Recommendation letter signed by head of the recommending institutions (please provide objective comments on the applicant, including whether the applicant is a student of Confucius Institute or other identity. Chinese language teachers shall submit an employment verification letter and a reference letter provided by the institutes they work for.)

For degree scholarship program applicants:

Certification of the highest education diploma (or proof of expected graduation), and an official transcript.

Applicants of the Scholarship for MTC SOL students are required to provide two references from professors or associate professors. Those who can provide an employment agreement or related documents with the designated teaching institution are preferred.

Disclaimer

1. Incomplete or unqualified applications will not be processed.
 2. Applicants will be disqualified from application in case of fraudulent application materials or application materials are completed and submitted by someone else.
 3. Scholarship winners who cannot register with our university on time should inform us about the reasons in written form within 15 days before the admission date. For those who do not register as requested without reason, the scholarship will be canceled.
 4. Scholarship will be canceled for those who do not pass the admission physical examination, drop out, or take schooling suspension during the study.
